

## **Garbage Disposal Troubleshooting**

## Garbage Disposal Care & Maintenance

- If the disposal isn't working, Check the following:
  - · Motor is plugged in
  - Air Switch is connected and plugged in (if an air switch is present)
  - GFCI outlet is on (not tripped)
  - The breaker is not tripped at the electric panel
  - Check the drain for any blockages/clogs/debris

## Disposal Clogged or Jammed

- -There is a manufacturer provided Allen wrench that can help manually grind through any debris that could be caught in the motor.
- -Using the Allen wrench gives you more Torque than the motor has.
- -If you must use the Allen wrench, then the motor has probably also overheated. If so, you'll need to hit the reset button on the bottom of the Disposal.

## Disposal Reset Button

- If the motor has overheated then the disposal will need to be reset.
- Run cold water through the drain and make sure any blockages or clogs have been removed.
- The red reset button will be sticking out and will need to be pushed back in.
- Restart the disposal and confirm it is working again.
