

General Guide for Maintenance and Care of Aprilaire humidifiers

REGULAR CLEANING:

Regularly clean your Aprilaire humidifier to prevent the buildup of mineral deposits, mold, and bacteria. Follow the manufacturer's instructions for cleaning procedures specific to your model. Typically, this involves removing and cleaning the water panel, reservoir, and any other accessible components.



CHECK AND ADJUST HUMIDITY LEVELS:

Monitor and adjust the humidity levels according to your comfort and the manufacturer's guidelines. Around 45-50 is recommended.

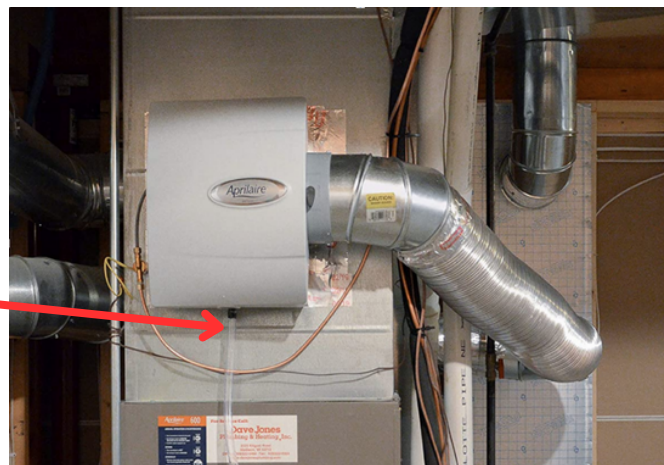


REPLACE THE WATER PANEL:
