

## **Cleaning Sink Aerators**

Sediment and debris can work its way into your home's plumbing. This debris can eventually reach faucets where it may be filtered by the aerator screen at the end of each faucet. If these aerators get clogged, water flow can be slowed down or stopped entirely. To remedy this, you can remove the aerators and rinse off debris.

These aerators can sometime be removed by hand by screwing off the end of the faucet. On some faucet types, a manufacturer key can be used as shown in the photos below.
